20,000 Spectators Line the Streets in Doylestown, PA, to Celebrate Memorial Day 2018



Ed Krensel, a Korean War Army veteran, has marched in many Memorial Day parades in Doylestown, PA, his hometown. This year he hitched a ride - along with Chet Furtek, a WWII Navy veteran who was on D-Day when he was just 18 years old - on Andy Janczak's Mustang convertible. Andy drove them along the parade route to the rousing cheers of more than 20,000 enthusiastic spectators. Matt Goldberg and his son, Zack, are seen carrying the banner in front of the car.

Ed and Chet are members of their local VFW (Veterans of Foreign Wars) Chapter. This was the 150th Anniversary of the Doylestown Memorial Day Parade which was first celebrated in 1868. It is the oldest continuously celebrated Memorial Day Parade in the U.S.
